"Hello, my name is Jane. I'm a proud Yorta Yorta women. That can stand up and get the word out there for women who are going through domestic violence and want to get out of it.

I am a strong powerful self-advocate women that gets the word out there for disabled people who want to know about their rights and not to be ignored and to know that they have got a voice to be heard.

I have been involved with the *Royal Commission* into Child Sexual Abuse. I have given talks to different groups including aboriginal groups in Alice Springs. In 2016 I got nominated for and won the *Human Rights Awards* as a person with an intellectual disability and a strong powerful aboriginal women. This award was for the whole of Australia for helping people to come forward to tell their stories about their abuse to the Royal Commission.

In 2017 I was nominated for the *Victorian Human Rights Awards* for telling my story at conferences and getting the word out there about your rights. I also won this award.

I have also done talks for *Office of the Public Advocate* about employing people with disabilities to help train workers and talk to clients."
