

What is in this kit?

- 1. 30 x Bingo Player sheets.
- 2. 26 x Bingo *Number Cards* (cut along dotted lines).
 - Some number cards have a question.
 - Place all *number cards* into a box for pulling out and calling.
- 3. 2 x make your own bingo counters (cut along dotted lines).

How to Play

- 1. Give out a bingo sheet to each person.
- 2. Pick a person to be the Bingo caller.
- 3. The caller then pulls out bingo number cards from the box.
- 4. The caller reads out the number on this card.
- 5. The players then place their counter on that number if they have it.
- 6. Read out the question on the number card.
- 7. Ask the players to answer or talk about the question.
- 8. After you have talked about the question pull out the next number and again read out the question.
- 9. You keep playing until someone calls bingo when they have a counter on all the number squares.
- 10. You do not need a counter on the middle square.



The right to be protected from Violence and Abuse
